Privacy Policy Statement:

The Deep South Cancer Foundation (DSCF) values and respects your right to privacy. Your privacy is important to us and so we are committed to protecting your privacy online and offline, and to that end have implemented and enforce the following policy.

Donor Information:

We recognize that providing us with personal information is an act of trust. As stewards of what you have provided, we take and treat all financial information about any transaction you have with the DSCF as **highly confidential**. Any information that is collected (your name, addresses, phone numbers, etc.) is done for internal use only. The DSCF **does not** share or exchange any of our donor's name, addresses, phone numbers, or e-mail addresses with other organizations. Additionally, the DSCF does not send donor mailings on behalf of other organizations.

About the information we collect on the web and how we use that information:

It is our policy to collect and store only the personally identifying information that visitors to our website knowingly provide. We do not collect any personal information from casual visitors browsing our website. When you use the public areas of our website you are doing so anonymously.

Our registration forms require users to give us contact information that may include name, email address, format preference (HTML vs. Text), address, interests, and similar information. We do not request or store sensitive information from our visitors, such as credit card or social security numbers.
